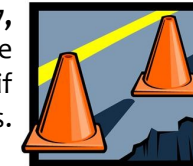

**PLEASE TAKE ACTION ON BILLS!**

**Assembly Bill (AB) 154 and AB 980 are two California abortion-expanding bills opposed by Bishop Soto and all of the California Bishops.** AB 154 would allow nurses, physician assistants and midwives (not well-trained physicians) to perform first trimester abortions. AB 980 would override the California Building Code requirements in favor of abortion facilities.
