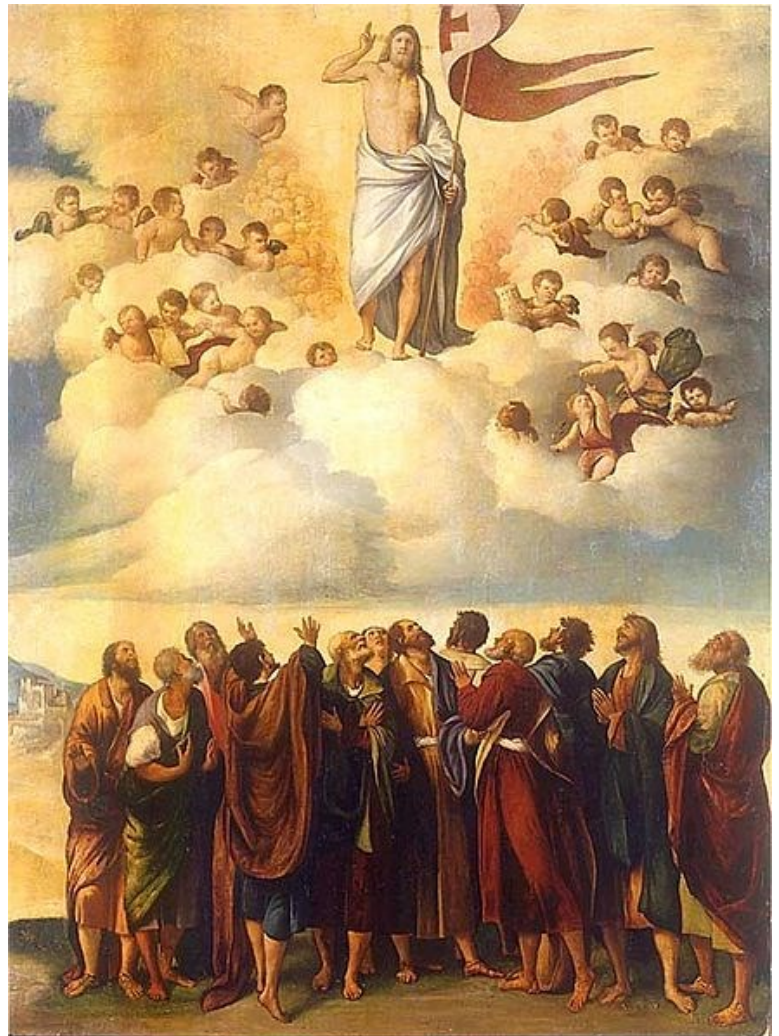

You need to be a registered member in order to receive any special privileges.

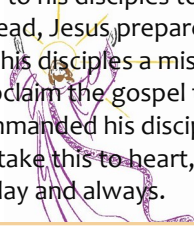
