

MISSIONARY COOPERATIVE APPEAL

The Missionary Cooperative Appeal is an annual program designed to increase awareness of missionary work and raise funds to support ongoing evangelization efforts.

The weekend of August 31st & September 1st, our parish will be visited by Fr. Reji with the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMI) Order, founded by St. Kuriakose Chavra is the first indigenous religious congregation in the Catholic Church of India. At present the Congregation has 2200 priests; 300 are doing pastoral services in 30 countries around the world. CMIs serve the people of God in different ways (hospitals, schools, orphanages, special schools, senior citizens homes, palliative care units, parishes, etc.).

The donations will be used for the development of 2 charitable institutions which was founded by Fr. Reji Joseph the former parochial vicar of St. Mary's, Vacaville.

- (1) Christ Health and Wellness Academy, Mysore. It is a special school for physically disabled children and youth. Multi-specialty rehab for psycho-socio-physical development. Here, we have 25 children who stay permanently with us and we provide them free physical aid such as medicine, food, special training, tuition etc.
- (2) Shanthi Nilaya Children's Home, Hallikarehundi: It is a resident for orphan (single parent) children. We take care of 20 poor children. We provide free food, medicine and accommodation. We have our own school to give them good education and training. Our future plan is to build a new house and chapel for these children. Our vision is to have sperate facilities for 25 girls and 25 boys. Our moto is "why can't a poor become doctors and engineers"?

Notice of Deadline for Filing Claims: October 1, 2024

YOU MAY HAVE A SEXUAL ABUSE CLAIM OR OTHER CLAIM AGAINST THE DIOCESE OF SACRAMENTO

On April 1, 2024, The Roman Catholic Bishop of Sacramento aka Diocese of Sacramento filed a chapter 11 bankruptcy petition for protection under title 11 of the United States Code.

If you were sexually abused by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim so as to be received by October 1, 2024, or otherwise you will be forever barred, estopped, and enjoined from asserting such claim against the Diocese.

Claims based on acts or omissions of the Diocese that occurred before April 1, 2024, must be filed on or before October 1, 2024, even if such claims are not now fixed, liquidated, or certain or did not mature or become fixed, liquidated, or certain before April 1, 2024.


